



# African Seasons

Wildlife sightings are usually best during the drier winter months, but each season has its own unique charm.


Summer is full of opportunities to witness spectacular sunsets and dramatic skies with afternoon thundershowers, while winter is best known for yellow and orange fire skies, filtered by dust.

Summer: Southern Africa is predominantly a summer rainfall area with the southwestern Cape of South Africa being the exception. Summer is the green season and time of abundance with birds, newborn animals and predators scattered all over. Clear, bright daylight is rounded off by spectacular colourful sunsets. Middays are usually warm and an ideal time to siesta under the air-conditioning while big clouds build up to create dramatic electrical afternoon thunderstorms.

Fall: April and May have the most moderate temperatures of the year. Some greenery remains from the summer rains, and it is then later absorbed by the pale dry wintertime. Fall is known for beautiful fresh mornings, moderate days, and cool evenings.

Winter: Winter is the dry season where limited availability of water results in high game densities around waterholes and wetlands. Visibility for animal sighting and photography is ideal as most of the leaves start to fall in the woodland areas. Winter mornings are colder but it heats up quickly during mid morning to mild day time temperatures.

**Spring**: Cool and crisp mornings that quickly warm up can be expected during the Spring. By the late afternoon clouds start to roll in holding the promise of rain to quench the winter thirst of land and animal.








# Specialized Veterinary Conservation Safaris



Safari Adventures offers a very unique 7 to 8 day veterinary conservation safari for either tourists or students. This safari package is ideal for prevets and veterinarians who want to get a glimpse into the life of a veterinarian working in South Africa.

The course will include the following:

- •Routine field work as well as attending to any emergencies that arise.
- •Predator conservation day at an accredited facility.
- •Visit to an animal rehabilitation facility and/or orphanage.
- •Darting practical including helicopter darting.
- •Wildlife necropsy procedure.
- •Set coursework covering the chemical immobilization of wildlife. A copy of the latest edition field manual will also be included in the course fees.
- •Potential registration for CPD points with the veterinary regulatory board (Certificate will be issued on completion)


